

# Raffle Tickets

These raffle tickets can provide the necessary motivation to have your students work towards no errors.

## Directions:

- Print several pages of raffle tickets and cut apart.
- Create a container to hold completed raffle tickets. Using a large clear plastic container with a hole in the top makes it possible for the students to see how many tickets are in the drawing. They seem to like this!
- Keep your extra raffle tickets close by or in your pocket.
- Explain to your students that each time they receive a 100% on any exercise to quietly raise their hand.
- Give the student a raffle ticket and thumbs up or a pat on the back depending upon your relationship with the student.
- Student will do nothing until the end of the class when they write their name on the ticket and place it in your raffle ticket drawing box.

## What do we win?

There is only one drawing a month! This cuts down on costs and time. Therefore, the prize needs to “look desirable”. Try placing all of the items that will be in this month’s drawing in the middle of a well-seen table on the first day of the month. Let the students look it over to see what’s in it and create excitement about the prize. Use your imagination and your knowledge of what your students care about. A paperback book, candy, stuffed animals, hall passes, pencils, pens, small toys or other school supplies can create enthusiasm. At the end of the day, tie it up with a bow and leave it visible to remind them what they could possibly win with their raffle tickets. On the last school day of the month during your last Autoskill group, pick your winner and make a big fuss over the winner. Tape the winning ticket on your door with the following note so each class knows who won. Enthusiasm, once again, is up to you. If you make a big deal of this incentive, your students will too!
